

How to wash concrete products







How to wash existing concrete products.

Cleaning concrete products will extend their life and enhance their beauty. It may be difficult to tell if concrete products need cleaning as the dirt and grime builds up over a period of time. Once products have been cleaned however, the results are very noticable.

Keep surface free of debris

Keep all surfaces free of debris by sweeping with a broom and rinsing with a hose.

Washing

You can wash your concrete products with soap and water and a brush. This will remove any dirt that has embedded on the concrete.

Power washing

Although soap and water alone can remove dirt from concrete power washing maybe needed for the more stubbon stains.

Ensure you prepare the concrete surface. Proper preparation is the key to successful concrete cleaning. It will make the job quicker and easier.

Test the spray on a small area to get used to its power. You may increase or decrease the power of the spray by adjusting the nozzle setting or the distance at which you are holding the wand from the concrete.

Work in a steady manner, pressure washing one section at a time before proceeding. This will ensure that there are no uneven streaks in the concrete once it has dried. Follow the slope of the concrete to optimise proper drainage.

Chemical Cleaning.
