What to do when you can't precast:

Sometimes no matter how you try it's just too cold, wet, hot to precast. In these cases if you have tried everything and you can't precast, (have a look at our other books on cold weather precasting etc).

So here are a few suggestions on what to do when you simply can't pour concrete:

- **Prepare**

If your using steel rebar in your products with spacers attached, then attach the spacers and prepare the frames. Get ready for when you will be able to precast

- **Clean**

This is always a good time to clean bits of your yard that may have needed attention for a while – sometimes cleaning up a yard can actually add a lot of valuable new space.

- **Take Stock**

Are your stock levels correct, do you know what you have exactly in your yard, do a stock take.

- **Plan**

- **Advertise**
